On **Sunday June 30th** (the day we are having 'Guess Who's Coming To Lunch'), there is another lunch option to consider!

The speaker at our morning services that day will be **John Tucker, the new Principal at Carey Baptist College**. After the 10.30am service, he'd like to have lunch with "a handful of people from WBC" who might be interested in "some kind of theological training" ...
