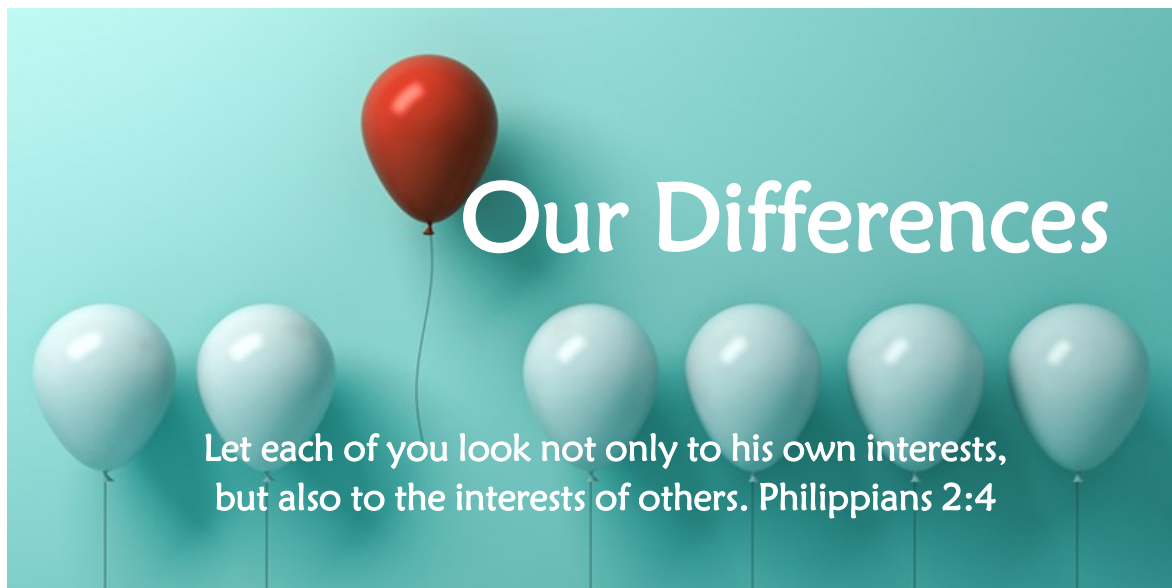

HAVING YOUR SAY?

MP Mark Mitchell is asking people who live in the Rodney electorate to let his office know whether they want the **End of Life Choice** (euthanasia and assisted suicide) Bill to become law. On **13 November** he intends to vote according to the view expressed by the **majority of communications received since mid October**. Even if you have contacted him before or made a submission, please contact him again. Couples, please send separate messages as individuals. You don't need to give a reason for your view unless asked.
