

‘SURPRISED BY HOPE’

Questions and Thoughts for Reflection and Discussion, relating to this morning’s sermon ...

1. Think about/discuss your thoughts and assumptions concerning “what happens when we die”. Where have these thoughts come from? How accurately do they reflect what the New Testament actually teaches?
2. Read 1 Corinthians 15:1-28, the Apostle Paul’s teaching on resurrection. What strikes you, perhaps even surprises you, from this passage.
3. Read Luke 24:28-32, 36-43; and John 20:19-28, and 21:1-14. Reflect on what these passages tell us about “bodily resurrection”.
4. Read Revelation 21:1-5. How does this vision fit with the idea of “bodily resurrection”?
5. In his book “Surprised By Hope”, Tom Wright describes the ultimate Christian hope as:

“the sure and certain hope of the resurrection of the body, rooted in the resurrection of Jesus Himself, and located within the promise of new heavens and new earth”.

If this is so, what might the implications be for our lives as disciples of Jesus here and now?

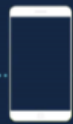
