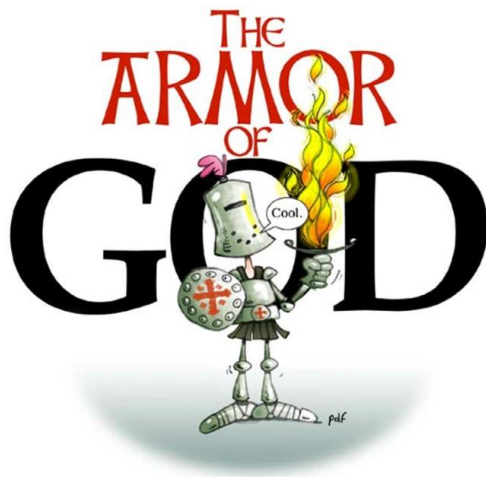

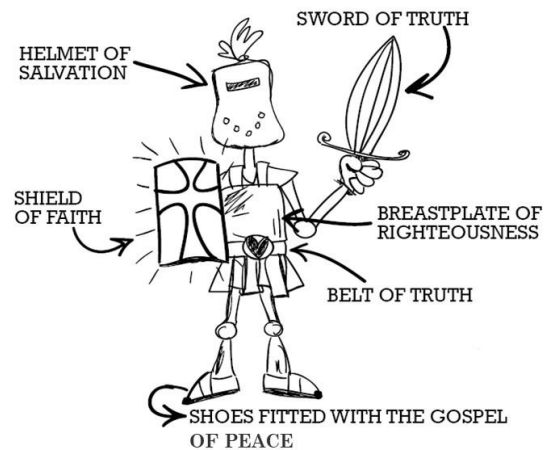

Mid-Service Activity Make a Sword Bookmark
