PRINT a mat (on page 2) for each person at the table or have one mat in the centre of the table. Use them as placemats during the meal.

(if you don't have a printer, then you could write down the questions on paper)

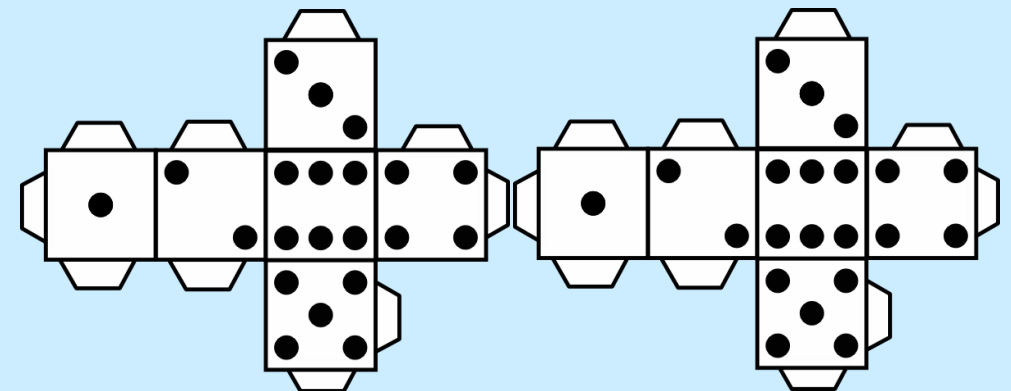

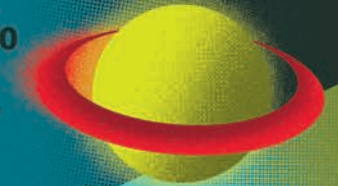

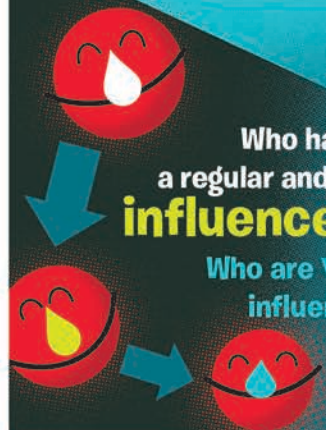
