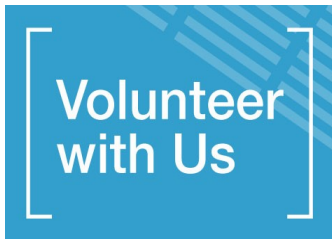

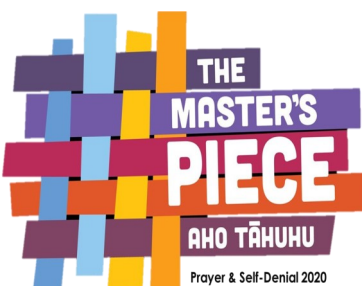
On December 6th and 13th during the 9.45am service there will be an opportunity on our volunteer clipboards to tick areas that interest you.

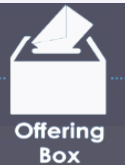
